116/02/25: TO INCORPORATE PARISH OWNED TREES LOCATED AT DARENTH ROAD SOUTH AS PART OF THE COUNCIL'S TREE MANAGEMENT PLAN

As part of the Parish Council's commitment to protect and maintain our rural and urban landscape, a Tree Management Policy was adopted in March 2022. Following this, a tree survey inspection was instructed and a Forestry Commission License obtained for a digital tree location map to be established. Initially the Tree Mapping and Inspection Survey Management Plan included trees situated at Lane End and Green Street Green wards. As part of this exercise, Parish owned trees were recorded on the Ordnance Survey Public Sector Geospatial Agreement (PSGA) mapping software which determined ownership, tree types and site location, with a further Inspection Survey carried out by our tree contractor.

Alltree Consultancy Ltd will carry out their follow-up tree inspection survey in April 2025 in line with the Council's Tree Management Policy. Members are asked to consider incorporating additional trees located at Darenth Valley ward, in line with the Council's long-term strategy of protecting and monitoring all Parish trees under the Tree Mapping and Inspection Survey Management Plan.

RECOMMENDATION: To approve Parish owned trees located at Darenth Road South in the Darenth Valley ward, be incorporated as part of the Council's Tree Mapping Inspection Survey from 1 April 2025.

117/02/25: TO CONSIDER HIGHWAYS IMPROVEMENT PLAN UPDATE

Darenth Parish Council submitted a Highways Improvement Plan (HIP) in August 2024. Our first proposal, being details relating to vehicular activity outside the Lane End Co-op, remains with the Kent County Council (KCC) Highways Engagement Team and we will be updated in due course.

Our second scheme suggestion, following a public engagement request, resulted in one resident asking to have the speed limit reduced from 40mph to 30mph at the junction of Green Street Green Road and Sandbanks Hill. Our subsequent HIP submission resulted in an automatic traffic counter (ATC) speed survey being carried out between 9 to 15 November 2024 to the West (west of Shellbank Lane), Mid (outside Green Spice) and East (east of Sandbanks Hill) on Green Street Green Road. Results from the survey showed the existing 40mph speed limit was well complied with and it would be unlikely to see reasonable compliance if the road was to be reduced to 30mph.

The Engagement Team has reported that to install a speed indicator device (SID) at this location, warning drivers of the speed limit, would cost in the region of £10k. KCC's Engagement Team Leader has indicated a £4k contribution towards the project.

Members are asked to consider the financial viability of committing to the remaining funding and confirm potential initiation of the project.

RECOMMENDATION: To consider and confirm if a speed indicator device is to be located at the junction of Green Street Green Road and Sandbanks Hill at a cost to the Parish of £6k.

The School has been duly informed, and Dartford Borough Council has confirmed weekly collections have been scheduled on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, at no extra cost to the Parish Council.
